

## A New Website for INS

You probably noticed our new look! We hope you enjoy the new capabilities of the INS site too!

This new site functions in many ways equal to our “old” website but now you have more capabilities. You can pay for your dues, order the print subscription to JINS and make a donation all in one transaction. And when it’s time to register for a meeting, you can combine that payment with your others too. Of course, you can still pay for just one item.

Now there is a “Read JINS online” link on the homepage. This link will take you to the login page for your INS account. Once logged in to your INS account, you will be taken directly to the Cambridge website where you will automatically be recognized as an INS member and given access to the journal. No more logging in on the Cambridge site too.

You log into your INS account using your email address and password, but now you have the capability to change your email address for future log-ins. Remember-it’s vitally important that you update your email address when needed. All communications from INS will be sent via email beginning in 2010.

Want to customize the information that appears in the member directory? Now you can add a personal website address to your listing or you can choose to exclude specific contact information from the directory. You can also designate a mailing address that is different from the address that appears in the directory.

And look for even more features in the future. We will be offering online Continuing Education credits for reading JINS articles, all future voting will be via your online account, and you will be able to complete evaluation forms for continuing education courses that you attend at the Annual and Mid-Year meetings.
